Bearing Witness

Texts: John 1:19-28

God has created each person with an original design and purposes for your life. Knowing who you are not allows you to receive and fully live into who God designed you to be.

John the Baptist's original design: (Luke 1:76-80)

Who John the Baptist is not (John 1:19-22):

- John is not the Messiah (John 1:20)
- John is not Elijah (John 1:21; Malachi 4:5-6)
- John is not The Prophet (John 1:21; Deuteronomy 18:15-18)

Who John the Baptist is (John 1:23-28):

- John is a voice in the wilderness, to prepare the way (John 1:23; Isaiah 40:3)
  - o God intends to use each person to point people to Jesus using the unique gifts, talents, and resources that He has entrusted to them.
  - o Question for Reflection: Who are the people that God has put in my life to make His love known? What resources, connections, gifts, talents, and resources has God given me to point people to Jesus?
- John is a baptizer in water (John 1:26; Luke 3:16)
  - o Bearing witness to Jesus means using our human resources while trusting God to do the supernatural.
- John is unworthy to untie Jesus' sandals (John 1:27)
  - o Bearing witness requires humility.
