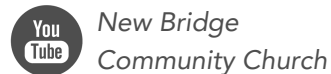
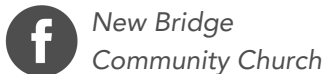

APRIL SCRIPTURE MEMORIZATION: PSALM 19:7-14

This week focus on meditating on and memorizing Psalm 19:11-12 (NLT): *They are a warning to your servant, a great reward for those who obey them. How can I know all the sins lurking in my heart? Cleanse me from these hidden faults.*

APRIL SPIRITUAL PRACTICE: SCRIPTURE

Reading Scripture invites us to connect to the very heart of God. We can look at nature or into a baby's eyes and be overcome with God's beauty and creativity. But we connect to God's heart and character in reading His Word. The Bible sets God out before us. It can be tempting to read the Bible in search of ourselves or for a solution to our current problems. Ask yourselves what does this passage reveal about God? As we seek God in the pages of the Bible, God reveals Himself to us.

"Then beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he (Jesus) interpreted for them the things concerning himself in all the Scriptures." (Luke 24:27)

Connection with God

God draws us to Himself through His Word. Focusing on God – His power, peace, love, etc. – dispels our temporal fears and anxieties. We can face all sorts of disruptions as we read the Bible, from technologies to noisy environments to our own racing thoughts. Practice a posture of receiving by going to a quiet place. I have found it to be helpful to jot down distracting thoughts and then place to the side in order to remove them from my mental plate. God meets us as we seek Him. In developing a regular practice of reading Scripture, I learned this prayer from Nicky Gumbel and use it to prepare my heart to read the Bible. "Lord, open my heart to Your Word and Your Word to my heart."

"You reveal the path of life to me; in your presence is abundant joy; at your right hand are eternal pleasures." (Psalm 16:11)
